MAIN CLASSES

1. ONE FLOWERING POT PLANT
2. ONE FOLIAGE POT PLANT
3. ONE AURICULA IN A POT
4. THREE TRUMPET DAFFODILS; yellow, one variety, one flower per stem, trumpet or corona as long or longer than the perianth (petals)
5. THREE DWARF DAFFODILS; any colour, one variety one flower per stem
6. THREE TRUMPET DAFFODILS; any colour other than yellow, one flower per stem, trumpet or corona as long or longer than the perianth
7. THREE LONG CUP DAFFODILS; any colour, one variety, one flower per stem, trumpet more than one third of the perianth, but less than equal to perianth
8. THREE SMALL CUP DAFFODILS; one variety, one flower per stem, trumpet not more than one third of perianth
9. THREE DOUBLE DAFFODILS; one variety
10. THREE MULTIHEADED DAFFODILS; any colour, one variety
11. THREE SPLIT CORONA DAFFODILS
12. CONTAINER OF MIXED VARIETY OF DAFFODILS; any number of blooms
13. FIVE TULIPS; one variety
14. CONTAINER OF FLOWERING SHRUB; one variety
15. FIVE TULIPS; mixed
16. CONTAINER OF ONE KIND OF FLOWER; other than daffodils and tulips
17. CONTAINER OF MIXED SPRING FLOWERS (no shrubs)
18. CONTAINER OF FLOWERING SHRUBS; mixed
19. AN ARRANGEMENT OF FLOWERS AND FOLIAGE; not exceeding 24" (60cm) in any direction
20. A MINATURE ARRANGEMENT OF FLOWERS AND FOLIAGE; not exceeding 4" (10cm) in any direction
21. THREE STEMS OF POLYANTHUS
22. SIX PANSIES; display board provided by the Society
23. CONTAINER OF HERBS

YOUNG PEOPLES' CLASSES (Up to the age of 11)

24. CRESS OR MUSTARD GROWN IN A NOVEL CONTAINER
25. A POSY OF SPRING FLOWERS FROM THE GARDEN (not picked from the wild)
26. SPRING FLOWERS PAINTED ON A PAPER PLATE
27. A DECORATED HARD BOILED EGG

PHOTOGRAPHIC CLASS

28. 'SPRINGTIME' maximum print size 8" X 6" - unmounted

29. A BOWL OR POT OF DAFFODILS - the bulbs were supplied by the society for members
